Your contribution will not only make the benefit to all the attendees but also the development of the field.



### **Submission Guideline of the 7th SPCS, CPMA & the 6th ICNE**

1. You can submit an abstract of a treatise, review or a case report on basic researches or clinical trials related to the field of cerebrovascular diseases and neurological disorders.
2. The submitted paper should be scientific, practical, and should have clear arguments and reliable data. The submitted paper should not be published elsewhere, and the authors should be responsible for the papers seriously.
3. The submitted paper should be written in Chinese or English.
4. Treatises and reviews can be submitted in the form of abstract (500-800 words) with 3 to 5 keywords, and the abstract of treatise should include four parts: Objective, Method, Result and Conclusion.
